## CONTEXTUALISED ADMISSIONS AND TRANSITION PROGRAMME

In2Surrey provides eligible applicants with an alternative grade offer and a programme of transition support from June to October, prior to enrolment at the University of Surrey.

### WHAT COULD IN2SURREY OFFER ME?

- A reduction in entry requirements, equivalent to one A-level grade lower\*
- Access to an E-Mentor (a current undergraduate student)
- Travel bursary for applicant events
- Invitations to exclusive transition events prior to enrolment

\*Please note that we may be unable to offer a reduction in entry requirements for BTEC students or those with unconditional offers. Students must still meet all the essential requirements of the course to which they have applied. Please see the Contextualised Admissions Policy on website for further details.

## HOW DOES IT WORK?

Contextualised admissions use information to understand the context in which you have achieved your qualifications, enabling us to identify performance and potential.

Depending on the criteria you meet, you will either be offered an automatic alternative grade via UCAS or you will need to apply to In2Surrey alongside your UCAS application. The eligibility criteria for each is detailed below.

Once you have confirmed the University of Surrey as your firm choice, you will receive an email inviting you to join our Transition Programme commencing in June.

### IN2SURREY

To be eligible to apply for In2Surrey, all applicants must:

- Be a home student, permanently residing in the UK
- Have previously studied at a state secondary school
- Have applied to study an undergraduate programme at the University of Surrey for the next academic year and have no previous degree qualifications
- Meet one of the following additional criteria:
  - You have been eligible to receive Free School Meals within the last 6 years
  - You are eligible for the 16-19 bursary
  - You are a refugee with indefinite leave to remain in the UK
  - You are from a Gypsy, Roma, Traveller, Showperson or Boater community
  - You are estranged from your family
  - You are a young carer or look after someone in your family
  - You are a mature or adult learner who will be aged 21 years or over when commencing your studies
  - You live in an IMD Decile 3 or 4 postcode\* You live in a POLAR4 Quintile 2 postcode\*

### AUTOMATIC OFFER

You will automatically receive a contextual offer if any one of the following criteria apply to you:

- You live in an area of high deprivation (IMD Deciles 1 and 2)\*
- You live in an area of low participation to Higher Education (POLAR4 Quintile 1)\*
- You have experience of being in care
- You have disclosed a disability or long term health condition
