### **Eligibility Criteria**

You are eligible for the Y10 Realise Your Potential if you are in Year 10 and meet one of the following selection criteria:

- You live in an IMD Decile 1 or 2 postcode\*
- You live in a POLAR4 Quintile 1 postcode\*\*
- · You have received Free School Meals within the last 6 years
- · You are a young carer
- · You have experience of living within care
- You are a forced migrant (e.g. a refugee or an asylum seeing young person)
- You are from a Gypsy, Roma, Traveller, Showperson or Boater community.

\*Indices of Multiple Deprivation are commonly used datasets to classify the relative deprivation within smaller areas of the UK. You can find an IMD look up tool on our website under the Surrey Scholars tab.

\*\*POLAR4 classifies the progression rate of young people in higher education within local areas across the UK. You can find a POLAR4 look up tool on our website under the Surrey Scholars tab.
