

RESIDENTIAL SUMMER SCHOOL CODE OF CONDUCT 2023

All students attending our Summer School have signed and agreed to follow our code of conduct as seen below.

This code of conduct has been written to ensure the wellbeing of each member of the programme. You will be expected to behave responsibly while attending the Summer School and show respect for the rights of other fellow students as well as the University staff and students helping with this Summer School. With respect to Health & Safety, you also have a legal duty under Common Law to take reasonable care.

The following rules will be in operation during the time you spend with us and must be followed at all times. Please read them carefully. It is a requirement of attending that you sign this code of conduct:

Please note that in these rules "Summer School staff" are defined to include staff, lecturers and Student Ambassadors.

• I will not leave University of Surrey premises unsupervised at any time during the Summer School.

• I will not involve myself in unauthorised activities that are likely to cause injury to students, staff or myself.

• I will respect the personal rights of all other staff and students and I will not indulge in abusive or anti-social behaviour or use sexist, racist or homophobic language.

• I will follow any emergency procedure, such as a fire drill, as directed by Summer School staff.

• I will respect property rights and I will not vandalise or damage any property belonging to the University of Surrey, staff or fellow students.

• I will commit to 100% attendance at lectures and evening activities during the Summer School and will ensure that I am on time every day.

• I will follow the accommodation rules set out by Summer School members of staff and I will keep to my own accommodation area and will not disrupt any other residents.

• I understand that, if I am under 18, I am not allowed to smoke during the Summer School, or bring cigarettes to the University of Surrey. If I am over 18, I will respect the University's non-smoking policy in the buildings, and smoke only in the designated areas.

• I will respect the no-alcohol policy in force during the Summer School and I will not bring alcohol to the University of Surrey or consume any during the Summer School.

• I will not attempt to sell, buy or use any illegal substances and I will not bring any illegal substances to the University of Surrey.

• I understand that the University of Surrey will not take responsibility for any valuable items bought onto campus by Summer School participants.

• I will not use mobile phones or headphones during timetabled activities and will pay attention during academic sessions at all times.

• I will behave responsibly and will comply with any reasonable request made by Summer School staff.

• I will accept and adhere to any additional rules set out by Summer School members of staff upon arrival at the University of Surrey.

• I understand that these rules apply to all participants regardless of age, including those who are 18 and over.

• I accept that anyone in breach of this code will be asked to leave the Summer School immediately. In this event, you as the participant or your parent/carer/supporter will be wholly responsible for arranging transport back home and will have to cover the full cost of this.
