Can the University of Surrey support me with my travel?

Yes, the Widening Participation & Outreach and HEON teams will make travel arrangements for you where requested. This includes train or taxi bookings dependent on distance travelled. All bookings and arrangements will be confirmed at least 1 week ahead of your arrival.

Can I travel to the University of Surrey by car?

You are very welcome to travel by car to the Summer School but you will not be able to park a vehicle overnight. Therefore, we recommend that you are dropped off at <u>Spine Road</u> on the Monday and collected on the Thursday. Further directions and drop off/pick up instructions will be shared ahead of your arrival.

I feel unwell before the Summer School, what should I do?

If you feel unwell ahead of your Summer School, we strongly encourage that you take precaution and, if possible, complete a Covid test before arriving on campus. If you test positive or are not well enough to attend on the morning of your Summer School starting, please contact us directly so that we can make alternative travel arrangements for you. If you feel unwell during the Summer School, please inform a member of staff as soon as possible.

Do I need to wear a mask when visiting the University of Surrey?

You are no longer required to wear a mask, but you are very welcome to wear one if you would prefer to do so.

Is accommodation provided at the Summer School?

You will be allocated your own room with private en suite. All rooms will also have access to a communal kitchen and have Wifi connection. Please note that participants are responsible for their own electronic devices and chargers.

Are meals included at the Summer School?

Yes, all main meals are provided throughout your Summer School week. Kitchens will be stocked with bottles of squash and sugar free snacks and there will be a kettle if you wish to bring your own hot drinks / pot pasta. A continental breakfast will be served every morning, and hot and cold food options will be available at lunch and dinner each day. All meal will be timetabled and all shared dietary requirements will be catered for. You can also bring your own snacks and money to make additional food purchases. We politely ask that you do not bring any nuts with you to the Summer School.
