### **Can the University of Surrey support me with my travel?**

Yes, the Widening Participation & Outreach Team will make travel arrangements for you where requested. This includes train or taxi bookings dependent on distance travelled. All bookings and arrangements will be confirmed at least 1 week ahead of your arrival.

### **Can I travel to the University of Surrey by car?**

You are very welcome to travel by car to the Summer School but you will not be able to park a vehicle overnight. Therefore, we recommend that you are dropped off on the Monday and collected on the Friday. Further directions and drop off/pick up instructions will be shared ahead of your arrival.

### **Is accommodation provided at the Summer School?**

You will be allocated your own room with private en suite. All rooms will also have access to a communal kitchen and have Wifi connection so that you can bring your own laptop. Please note that participants are responsible for their own electronic devices and chargers.

### **Are meals included at the Summer School?**

Yes, all main meals are provided throughout your Summer School week. All meals will be timetabled and all shared dietary requirements will be catered for. You can also bring your own snacks and means to make additional food purchases (please note that our campus is cashless). We politely ask that you do not bring any nuts with you to the Summer School.
